

<b>T1</b>	Invasive cancer is beyond the epithelial layer, but confined to the vocal cords, and both vocal cords move normally.
<b>T1a</b>	T1 cancer is limited to only one of the vocal cords.
<b>T1b</b>	T1 cancer extends onto both vocal cords, including the anterior commissure.
<b>T2</b>	Cancer extends from the vocal cords either to the supraglottis or into the subglottis; and/or the vocal cords do not move normally.
<b>T3</b>	Cancer is confined to the boundaries of the larynx, but it has caused a vocal cord to stop moving, or the tumor is growing into the paraglottic space, or the tumor is growing into the inner part of the thyroid cartilage.
<b>T4a</b>	Cancer has invaded through the thyroid cartilage and/or is growing into tissues beyond the larynx.
