AUA2023 plenaries build strong foundation



// All of the most important and practice-changing lectures, panel discussions and guidelines will be presented during these eight morning and afternoon plenary sessions."

Welcome to the 2023 AUA Annual Meeting in Chicago. AUA2023 offers more information and more learning opportunities than there are hours to absorb them all. Attending the plenary sessions each day means making the most of your time in Chicago.

"We have dozens of educational courses, specialty society gatherings and more, but the plenary is the main

focus of our Annual Meeting," said AUA Secretary John Denstedt, MD, FRCSC, professor of urology at Western University in London, Ontario, Canada. "All of the most important and practice-changing lectures, panel discussions and guidelines will be presented during these eight morning and afternoon plenary sessions. The last plenary of the meeting, on Monday from 1 to 4:10 p.m., wraps up the key take-home messages from

AUA's most intense learning experience of the year."

Dr. Denstedt attended his first AUA annual meeting as a resident in 1987 and has attended every meeting since. As AUA secretary, one of his key roles is supporting the development of the Scientific Program for AUA2023. All the plenary sessions take place in Hall B1.

"Our very first lecture, a state-of-the-art lecture on "The Future of Interventional

Urology: The Next Paradigm Shift" (today from 7:30 to 7:45 a.m.), is one of the most important reasons to be in Chicago," Dr. Denstedt said. "Urologists today are adapting the most effective minimally invasive imaging techniques from interventional radiology to the urological disorders we treat every day. This is a look at where urology is going from one of the key movers who is leading the way, Art Rastinehad, DO, vice chair of urology at Lenox Hill Hospital and system director for prostate cancer at Northwell Health System. This lecture will explore aspects of how we all think about the practice of urology."

The next milestone today is a panel discussion on "Triple Therapy vs. Chemotherapy/

ADT for Newly Diagnosed mHSPC Patients (Treatment Intensification)" from 8:35 to 8:55 a.m. The panel will take a hard look at the latest data on treating metastatic hormone-sensitive prostate cancer.

Today also launches the first sessions dedicated to new AUA Guidelines: "Early Detection of Prostate Cancer" from 10:10 to 10:25 a.m. Other guideline updates focus on "Upper Tract Urothelial Carcinoma (UTUC)" today from 1:55 to 2:05 p.m. and "Urethral Stricture Disease" on Saturday from 8:25 to 8:55 a.m.

The first of four semi-live surgery presentations takes place today and will focus on oncology with bladder, renal and prostate cancer surgeries from 10:40 to 11:30 a.m., followed by the latest endourologic approaches for renal stones from 3:25 to 4:25 p.m. Sexual medicine is the focus Sunday morning from 10:45 to 11:10 a.m. with an afternoon session exploring four different approaches to BPH from 3:20 to 4:30 p.m.

The final must-see today is a Crossfire Debate on the "Impact of PSMA-PET on Treatment Decision-Making" from 2:55 to 3:25 p.m. ●

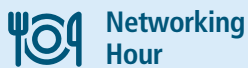

AUA2023 education offers something for everyone

This year's AUA Annual Meeting has upped the number of new educational courses for attendees compared to 2022, and there is plenty to take advantage of regardless of where you are in your career.

"I am delighted that we are offering 19 new instructional courses and one new hands-on course for our attendees," said Jay Raman, MD, FACS, professor of urology at Penn State Health Milton S. Hershey Medical Center in Hershey, Pennsylvania, and chair of the AUA's Office of Education. "Roughly, this translates to almost 25% new course offerings for the 2023 Annual Meeting."

To provide the highest quality of educational offerings, Dr. Raman said the Office of Education placed an emphasis on

increasing the diversity of course offerings as well as incorporating new speakers and content. Not surprisingly, the pandemic has impacted course formats, as well.

"In the post-COVID education landscape, it is clear that learning and surgical education are evolving," Dr. Raman said. "The classic model of purely didactic education has declining interest while digital interfaces, surgical simulation and hands-on strategies have significant appeal for the modern-day learner and trainee."

Not sure where to start amidst all the new options? Dr. Raman has a few recommendations.



For the seasoned urologist

Science doesn't pause when you graduate from med school. Fortunately, AUA stays abreast of important developments to share with attendees.

"A critical component of daily practice is keeping up to date on new AUA guidelines and providing the means to integrate these into clinical practice," said Dr. Raman. "At this year's AUA, we have more than 10 guidelines-focused courses, including those new guidelines being released at the Annual Meetings, such as 'Early Detection of Prostate Cancer' and 'Upper Tract Urothelial Carcinoma.'"



For early career colleagues

A successful career in medicine involves more than just being well-versed in your specialty.

"We understand that a significant component of practice is not just clinical medicine but also career development and navigating the workplace environment," said Dr. Raman. "In that regard, two new courses delve into these domains: 'Building Successful Mentor-Mentee Relationships' and 'Workplace Safety and Security/Active Shooter—Violent Encounter/Cyber Threats/Work and Home.'"



For anyone who has a few free minutes in their schedule

Swing by the surgical education poster and podium abstract sessions. "We have a number of innovative strategies that are being presented, many of which can be incorporated readily into surgical training," said Dr. Raman.

Feeling a bit overwhelmed at the number of options in the agenda? Dr. Raman has suggestions for that, too.

"The Annual Meeting can sometimes be intimidating due to the myriad activities that are concurrently being presented," he said. "A wonderful feature of this AUA2023 meeting is that almost all instructional courses are also available as a virtual livestream or post-course on-demand video format for up to three months after the meeting. This allows the attendee to maximize educational exposure without having to choose between different courses or meeting content."

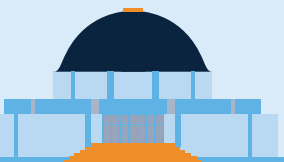

More than 30 potential employers will be on hand offering their latest and greatest jobs as well as opportunities to network with other professionals in the urology field Sunday from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. in the Grand Ballroom Lobby on Level 1. Kelly Krause, senior manager of event strategy and planning for Health eCareers, said attending the in-person

Career Fair is a good move no matter where you are in your career.

"It's the perfect venue for an event like this because a lot of the [AUA] members are in one place," she said. "It gives them the opportunity to network and start their job search if they are in their final years of residency or new to practice or even if they are late-stage career and are just looking for their next journey."

Employers looking to help take urologists on that journey include Adventist Health, Covenant HealthCare, Kaiser Permanente, Mercy Clinic, Summit Health Medical Group, Universal Health Services.

After the last few years of virtual events necessitated by the COVID-19 pandemic, Krause said people are excited

to have career fairs like this live and in person again.

"Virtual events took off at the start of COVID because it was new, and it was the only way to connect in a safe way," she said. "But now, after two and a half years of doing virtual events, we're starting to see a downward trend in registration and engagement for those because people want to get back to in-person events."

That doesn't mean the virtual events are going away. Far from it. Krause said there is a virtual event in the works for later this year that will tie in with the Career Fair at AUA2023. In the meantime, the in-person fair is free, and everyone attending will have their badge scanned to make it easier to share their information with employers.



If you need more help or information, the AUA Job Finder Kiosk will be open both Saturday and Sunday in The Square near AUA Central. There, both job candidates and employers can visit and learn about the AUA Job Board.

"We can walk candidates through how to set up a job alert and apply filters so they can tailor their search to the

exact job criteria they are looking for," Krause said. "On the other end, we can help members who are hiring post their job opportunities on the job board." •

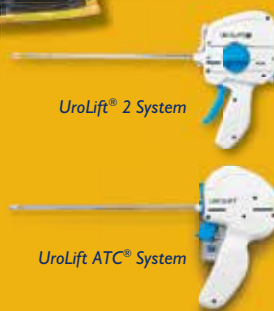

AUA History Booth spotlights urology in wartime.

War! What is
it good for?
In this case,
learning.

The AUA History Booth will trace the role urology played during wartime as part of its “Battlefield Urology,” in Booth #1342 in the Science & Technology Hall. The exhibit explores how war affected the specialty of urology, and how urology impacted historical battles in war.

This year’s exhibit, sponsored by UroGen in an adjacent booth, is curated by Mark Edney, MD, retired lieutenant colonel in the U.S. Army Reserve and veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Dr. Edney served as section representative to the AUA Public Policy Council from 2012-2018 and helped obtain support for troops suffering from urotrauma. He currently serves as editor of the Business Section of *Urology Practice*® and is incoming chair of the AUA Public Policy Council. Dr. Edney will present “Genitourinary

Trauma in the Military” at the Battlefield Urology Booth today at 10 a.m.

Dr. Edney and AUA Historian Ronald Rabinowitz, MD, FACS, FAAP, professor of pediatric urology at the University of Rochester Medical Center in Rochester, New York, will moderate the popular Forum on the History of Urology today from 1 to 5 p.m. in Room S105BC and participate in the included debate on “Wartime Triage: Military versus Civilians.” At 3 p.m., the History Forum features its Bicknell Lecture with Steven Hudak, who will present “Battlefield Genitourinary Injury: Past, Present and Future.”

“In addition to the ethics debate and the Bicknell Lecture, the History Forum includes 14 posters and 20 podium presentations, the highest graded of the record 115 submitted abstracts,” Dr. Rabinowitz said. “At the History Exhibit, attendees can pick up a ‘battlefield newspaper’ containing 22 articles describing the effect of war on urology and the effect of urology on war.”

Speakers at the History Booth over the course of three days (Friday and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.) include:

- Sam Donnenfeld, MD, “Variocoeles and the Military”
- Drs. Kevin Pranikoff and Rabinowitz, “VD and the Battlefield”
- Barbara Chubak, MD, “GG Smith: A Urologist on the Western Front”
- Sutchin Patel, MD, “John K. Lattimer: World War II Veteran and Historian”
- Arthur Burnett, MD, “Successful Penile Transplantation in a Military Veteran”
- Jennifer Gordetsky, MD, “Annie, Annie: Are You OK? Death Masks, War, and Simulation”

- Friedrich Moll, MD, “Impetus for German-Speaking Urology.”

This year, the History Booth also will feature a look at Intuitive’s da Vinci® Surgical System (Standard) introduced in 1999—a urologic medical advance that grew from military technology.

Dr. Gordetsky, professor of pathology and urology at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville hosts this year’s games, “Lies, Damn Lies and Medical History.” Winners will be awarded prizes and plenty of museum “swag.” Be sure to enter the History Booth raffle; one winner will receive a special military history prize.

UCF grows global humanitarian efforts

Through three initiatives, UCF improves urological care across the world.

If you missed the boat on the sold-out benefit for the Urology Care Foundation (UCF) that takes place tonight, have no fear—you can still contribute to the cause. In an effort to bring improved urological care to patients suffering around the world, the UCF continues to grow its humanitarian initiative and deepen its commitment to fund research, develop patient education and enhance humanitarian initiatives.

Your gift to the UCF goes a long way, with 81% of funds raised going directly to the UCF's mission. Harris M. Nagler, MD, FACS, president of the UCF, is particularly eager to highlight the foundation's humanitarian programs, which are the newest in the efforts of the foundation. These initiatives to improve urological care across the world come in three forms: the Humanitarian Recognition Awards, the Humanitarian Grant Program and the Health Equity Fellowship.

Humanitarian Recognition Award

The UCF Humanitarian Recognition Award distinguishes individuals who have demonstrated a commitment to improving access to quality urological health care for underserved populations. The 2023 winner is Serigne Magueye Gueye, MD, FWACS.

"Although physicians have been recognized by their peers for their work in the past, the UCF felt there needed to be a formal way to highlight the important efforts of these individuals," Dr. Nagler said. "This award reflects this critical part of our mission as urologists, physicians and fellow human beings. It demonstrates to young urologists that we value the commitment of these humanitarians and, hopefully, will encourage others to pursue such efforts."

Humanitarian Grant Program

The UCF Humanitarian Grant Program, which is accepting applications until May 15, will provide funding to support the efforts of individuals and projects that provide direct urological patient care in underserved areas both within the U.S. and around the world.

"We can all be proud of the recipients of these grants as they reflect the spirit of true humanitarianism—they give of themselves without expectation of remuneration and provide services to those who are in need and underserved," said Dr. Nagler. "They do the hard work, the rewarding work, and we are pleased to have the opportunity to support them

thanks to our many generous donors."

Health Equity Fellowship

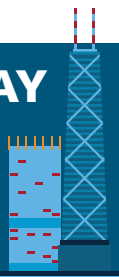
The new Health Equity Fellowship is a two-year program for early-career urologists who are passionate about humanitarian work within the United States. The first year of the program will consist of didactic education in partnership with the Center for Urban Bioethics at the Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University in Philadelphia. In year two, the fellow will receive a stipend and ongoing mentoring to carry out a capstone project developed in year one.

"The Urology Care Foundation seeks to be a leader in the urological community by fostering and supporting humanitarian efforts that address health care inequities related to limited access to care and knowledge of urological conditions," said Dr. Nagler. "We are proud to announce the creation of the Health Equity Fellow Program, which will train early career urologists who are passionate about humanitarian work within the U.S."

Applications are now open. "Please go the website to learn more about the program and apply!" he said. "We need to develop our future leaders." •

Residents Bowl kicks off today

New and returning international societies vie for bowl champion.

The AUA is bringing the fun-filled Residents Bowl competition to Chicago today with teams from around the country—and participants from around the world. Organized by the AUA Residents & Fellows Committee, this year's games will be moderated by Drs. Gary Faerber (Duke University Medical Center) and Bradley F. Schwartz (Southern Illinois University).

Amanda Burns, member engagement and marketing specialist with the AUA

and coordinator of the competition, said the 10th annual event will feature participants from eight AUA Sections based in the U.S., and each team will include a participant from one of eight participating international society partners.

This year, the Urological Society of Australia and New Zealand has returned to the competition with a delegate from New Zealand, and the Sociedad Colombiana de Urología will be sending someone to compete for the first time.

"Each of the Section teams is assigned an international participant," Burns said. "I think for these international trainees it is a real honor to represent their country and their region."

Other participating countries include Brazil, Egypt, India, Italy, Japan and the United Kingdom.

The eight teams will compete by answering questions in front of a live audience, quiz-style. Questions cover a wide range of topics including urological subspecialties, the history of urology and new findings in research. There are also bonus questions, lifelines and passes built into the games to make them even more interactive.

- Good Will Shunting from the New England Section
- Transurethral Residents of NY (TURNY) from the New York Section

- Eggplant Deformity from the North Central Section
- Win By A Vas Deferens from the Northeastern Section
- Golden Rocket from the South Central Section
- SES 20cm x2 3cm RTE from the Southeastern Section
- Phallic Philosophers from the Western Section

Samuel Ivan, MD, PGY-4 urology resident at Carolinas Medical Center in Charlotte, North Carolina, is part of the Southeastern Section team this year and also serves as the Southeastern Section representative to the AUA Residents & Fellows Committee. Dr. Ivan said he is grateful for the opportunity to represent his Section this year.

"I am excited for the opportunity to build

relationships with urology trainees from across my Section, the country and the world," he said. "None of us can resist a good competition and what better way to compete than with some urology trivia and history! Plus [as part of the audience] you can cheer on your Section and see if you can come up with some answers yourself."

The preliminary rounds of the competition kick off today from 1 to 2 p.m. and 3 to 4 p.m. The semifinals will take place with the four remaining teams from 1 to 2 p.m. tomorrow. The final two teams will square off to decide the ultimate winner at 1 p.m. on Sunday.

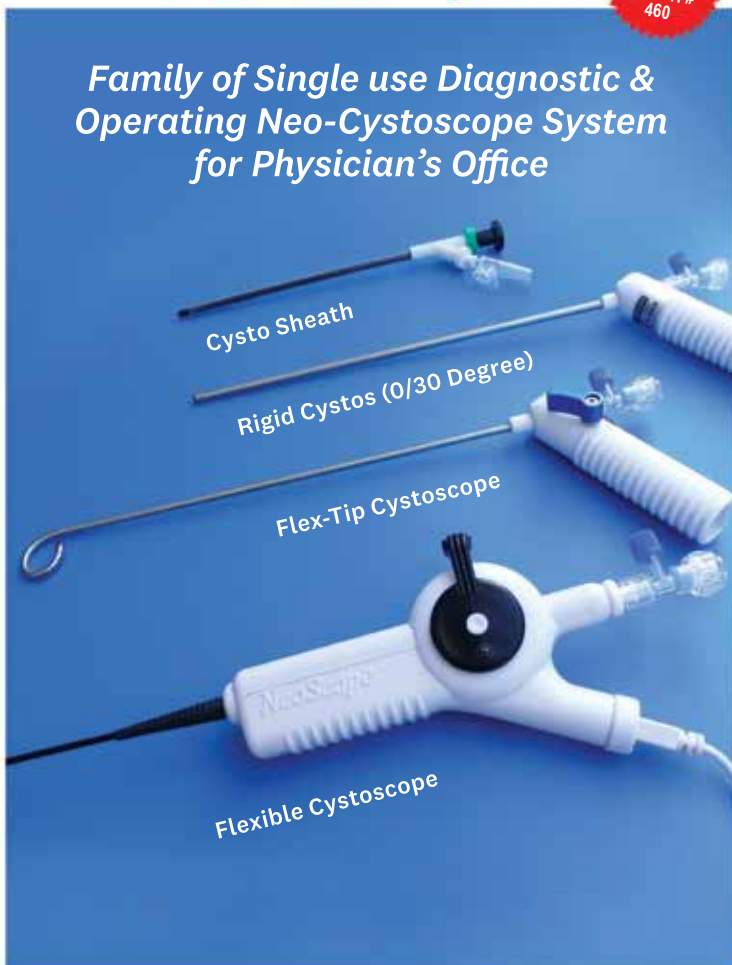
