## Table 1: Goals of editorial peer review

- 1. Assist editors in making decisions about publishing a manuscript
- 2. Offer constructive feedback to authors that will enhance the final writing product
- 3. Improve critical thinking and writing skills of editors, reviewers, and authors
- 4. Provide readers, researchers, and other users of the journal with polished, readable articles
- 5. Reduce bias and improve the quality of published articles
- 6. Ensure that published research adheres to ethical standards for biomedical publishing
